## Village Board Business

Motion Trustee Ippolito, Jr. and Seconded by Trustee Balcaen to approve claims (which consist of gas and electric bills) that have to be paid before August 14, 2014 totaling: General - \$16,135.18, all were in favor and carried.

Discussion with Will Barham, Code Enforcement Officer and Jake Swingly, Superintendent of Public Works regarding updates to Village Code as recommended by General Code.

Discussion on possible date change for Village Board Meeting from Thursday, September 11, 2014 to Wednesday, September 10, 2014 because of a conflict with the 9/11 Ceremony at 7:00 p.m. at the Gazebo in Veterans Park on North Avenue.

Discussion with Jake Swingly, Superintendent of Public Works regarding Village Days and the participation of the Department of Public Works staff on Saturday August 16, 2014.

Discussion regarding emergency assistance from the Village of Webster DPW staff sent to Honeoye Falls on July 14, 2014. This assistance was in accordance with the countywide agreement for fleet services, machinery, tools, equipment and services sharing. The Village of Webster has received a Thank You letter from Mayor Richard B. Milne of Honeoye Falls for the support we provided to them during the aftermath of a microburst storm that impacted their community on July 8, 2014. The letter further stated that Honeoye Falls was requesting disaster relief in financial support from the State of New York. If Honeoye Falls does receive financial assistance then they will compensate the Village of Webster for the services of the DPW staff.

Discussion on amending Policy 2-6 Meeting Conduct to add the following rule:

- 9 ~~The Chair~~ of Any Board, Commission or Committee may remove any person or persons whose actions are in violation of Meeting Conduct Rules or whose conduct is, obtrusive or disruptive, upon a majority vote.

Discussion regarding parking during the summer months on the village streets. Should the same rules apply as during the winter months or should parking be allowed anytime during the summer?
