Village Board Business

A presentation was shared by Peter Elder, Board Member of the Historic Preservation Commission regarding the Freight Depot Restoration. Mr. Elder said he is Chairman of a 501C3 not for profit C Corporation. The corporation is called Friends of Webster Historic Preservation and this group will accept and raise money for the completion of the Freight Depot Project.

Mr. Elder discussed an outline which included three phases. Phase I included the dismantling and removal of the Freight Depot from its current site. The wood is being stored at the Well Field property through September 2016. A new site will be found to relocate the depot. Phase II will entail the reconstruction of the Freight Depot building onto the new approved sight. Phase III will involve a plan for ongoing maintenance of the Freight Building.

Motion Trustee Ippolito, Jr., and Seconded by Trustee Lancy to approve payment of a dental invoice for Jim Scott not to exceed \$105.69 due to the falling through the cracks of his timely submission of paperwork in 2013 but not getting to the insurance company, all were in favor and carried.

Mayor Cahill said he wanted to review and discuss in the next Village Board Meeting on October 8, 2015, the Village employee policy section 8-3 vacation time pertaining to "The Village Clerk and Treasurer in addition to the years of service credit for vacation may receive an additional week of vacation on their anniversary dates to offset additional work performed that exceeds their standard work week."

Jake Swingly, Superintendent of Public Works said he would like to discuss in the next Village Board Meeting seasonal help.
